#### **Greek**: parthenos

**Definition:** Virgin, a maiden; extended to men who have not known women.

**Usage:** The Greek word "parthenos" primarily refers to a virgin, typically a woman who has not engaged in sexual relations. In the New Testament, it is used to describe both literal and metaphorical purity. **The term can also refer to a young woman of marriageable age, emphasizing her chastity and purity.**

#### v. 32-34 Describe Reality

#### v. 35-38 Give Options

I say this for your own benefit, not to lay any restraint upon you, but to promote good order and to secure your undivided devotion to the Lord.
